

Policies regarding specialty examinations

Both the Specialty Written Examination (SWE) and Specialty Clinical Examination (CE2) score reports will remain valid for a three year period. This applies to all the Certificates of Assessment effective the 2007-2008 application cycle.

It is mandatory to pass both the written and clinical examinations in order to be eligible for a PGY2 or PRA position.

Candidates may elect to repeat an exam (for example, if their score was not high and they would like another opportunity to demonstrate their skills). It is important to note that only the results of the most recently taken examination will be provided to Program Directors during an application cycle.

Example 1:

- Written exam 2007-2008 failed
- Clinical exam 2007-2008 passed
- Written exam retaken 2008-2009 passed

Results that will be provided to the Program Directors are the Written Exam results from 2008-2009 and the Clinical Exam results from 2007-2008.

Example 2:

- Written exam 2007-2008 passed
- Clinical exam 2007-2008 passed
- Clinical exam retaken 2008-2009 passed

Results that will be provided to the Program Directors are the Written Exam results from 2007-2008 and the Clinical Exam results from 2008-2009.

Example 3:

- Written exam 2007-2008 passed
- Clinical exam 2007-2008 passed
- Clinical exam retaken 2008-2009 fail

Candidate will not be eligible for a PGY2 or PRA position.
